

Afghan Democracy – Voting rights for all Afghans worldwide!

Every human being has natural rights and it is essential to preserve them. In a democratic country like Afghanistan voting rights are such natural rights. According to article 11 of the Afghan Electoral Law every Afghan, regardless of his or her residence, is eligible to vote and thus may participate in the elections, if he/she

1. *has completed eighteen years of age at the time of the election*
2. *has Afghan citizenship at the time of registration*
3. *is not deprived of any political and civil rights by an authoritative court*
4. *is registered in the voters registration list.*



But how does the implementation look like?

The sad truth is that Afghans in exile do not have the opportunity to participate in elections. They are deprived of their rights and their voices are silenced. If you also think that we should oppose this injustice, then take part in the petition.

At a rate of 50.000 votes we will contact the Afghan Independent Electoral Commission and enforce the claim for voting rights of all Afghans.
